



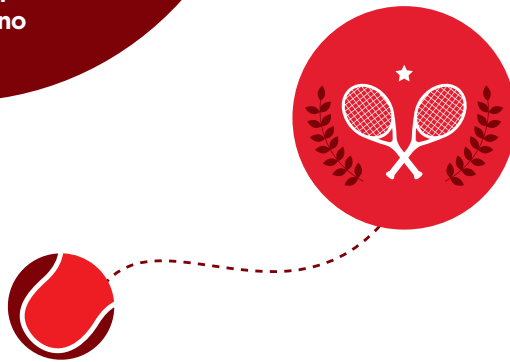
The 2018 Canadian tennis season by the numbers
