Facilities:

- Players may park in the parking lot accessed off of Fir Street or off of 16th Avenue. The underground gated parking is reserved for Members only. Please register your license plate at Member Services.
- Please book Registered Massage Therapy or Kinesiology services through Member Services. Payment is due upon booking.
- Racquet stringing is available in the Sport Shop for a fee.

Important Club Rules:

- Talking on cell phones is not permitted. Please turn your phone to silent before entering the Club. Email/text is allowed.
- White court attire is required. Each item of visible clothing including hats, headbands, athletic socks, and warmups must be predominantly white. No more than 10% color on each item of visible clothing. Colored shoes are ok.
- Clay courts- for those playing on this surface, you are required to change your shoes before leaving the courts. Shoes worn on the clay courts are not permitted anywhere else in the Clubhouse.
- We do not accept cash anywhere in the Club. Debit or credit can be used in the Sport Shop and food and beverage areas. Note that outside food and beverages are not permitted.

Water

Water machines and fountains available. Bottled water available for sale. Only closed containers on the court.

Food & Beverage

Outside food and beverage are not permitted. Players' Lounge open 8am-4pm daily. Pub open 4pm-11pm daily (Note: Food service available until 10:00pm & drink service available until 10:30pm.)

To the participants of the 2022 Steve Stevens Senior Nationals:

Welcome to the Richmond Tennis Club (RTC). We are proud to be a host club of the Nationals for the first time. RTC is a semi-private club situated in Minoru Park in central Richmond. As such, we do not have the full facilities of a private club but have a clubhouse with kitchen and lounge, and our spacious court layouts and conditions are second to none. Our location within the Richmond Minoru Park complex puts us close to many facilities. We recently hosted the 58th Annual Richmond Open from which the surveyed participants' responses were overwhelmingly enthusiastic for RTC's hospitality and relaxed ambience.

Facilities:

Our clubhouse includes change rooms with showers (no lockers), filtered water cooler, and check-in desk with a variety of cold drinks for purchase. We have a 2nd floor deck with views to our 5 outdoor courts, of which 4 will be used for the tournament. We are a 2-minute walk from the Minoru Centre for Active Living (MCAL) which features lap pools, a family pool, a hot pool, a cold pool and a fully equipped gym. The drop-in rate is \$7.45. Locker rental is \$0.25.

Food and Drink:

We do not have in-house dining facilities, but MCAL has a well-regarded cafeteria that is open Monday to Friday from 8:30 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. where the lunch of the day can be had for \$10.50. Richmond Centre Mall is a 10-minute walk from RTC. It has a diverse food court and several stand-out chain restaurants, Cactus Club and White Spot. Richmond is famous for its excellent Asian restaurants and participants will be provided with a list of member favourites, both Asian and other.

Parking:

Minoru Park has free parking. Unless there is a special event in the park, there is ample parking around the Club and MCAL.

Practice Courts: Unfortunately, we are not able to offer practice times but there are 5 public courts adjacent to the club with similar courts.
